The shift

- Sound recordings allowed for a new appreciation of song and narrative
- An emphasis on the place of the item within the community
 - Not irrespective of its “traditionality,” but not having the abstract concept of “traditional” being the sole criterion



MUNFLA

- Memorial University of Newfoundland Folklore and Language Archive
- Founded in early 1960s as a repository for student collection exercises and faculty research
- Became basis for most of the folkloristic research conducted in NL in the last forty years
