Princely Ifinedo is currently an Associate Professor of MIS/Management Science at Cape Breton University (CBU), Sydney, Nova Scotia, Canada. Dr. Ifinedo received his tertiary education in three continents. Dr Ifinedo's teaching philosophy is informed by the nurturing and developmental theories.
